

- **Travel is permitted on designated, blazed trails only.** The trails are clearly marked
- Off-trail travel may damage the forest resources or pose a safety hazard to other forest users. ATV/OHM riding on undesignated or unmarked routes is a violation of federal law.
- **All ATVs must have both a valid, current registration and insurance. Operators must provide documented proof and have this documentation in their possession.** Registration must be in accordance with Commonwealth of Pennsylvania law or the law in a state that offers reciprocity with Pennsylvania. Registration is available at local ATV dealers or with the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources Snowmobile/ATV Registration Section. The registration fees are used to help maintain the ATV trail system.
- **ATV/OHM use during closed trail seasons is not permitted.** Mountain bikes and horses are permitted to use the trails year-round.
- **It is illegal to operate an OHV while under the influence of any amount of drugs or alcohol.**
- **All operators and passengers must wear a DOT or Snell-approved helmet.**
- All operators must be at least 8 years of age.**
- **All operators between ages 8 and 15 must have an ATV safety training certificate in their possession.**
- **All operators between ages 8 and 15 must have an adult accompany and supervise them.**
- **Passengers 8 years of age and older may only ride on an ATV with an approved after market seat.**
- **Passengers under 8 years of age can only ride in a "Side by Side ATV" with an approved child safety seat. Any passenger less than 4 years of age, or weighing less than 40 lbs., or under the height of 4'9" tall must use a child restraint device. Any passenger between ages 4 and 7 and weighing less than 80 lbs. and/or any passenger under the height of 4'9" must be fastened in an ATV seat belt system with the use of an approved booster seat.**
- **Certificated operators ages 8 and 9 are restricted to an ATV/OHM with an engine size of 70cc or less.**
- **Mufflers and spark arresters are required on all ATV/OHM machines.**
- **ATV/OHM lights must be used between sunset and sunrise.**

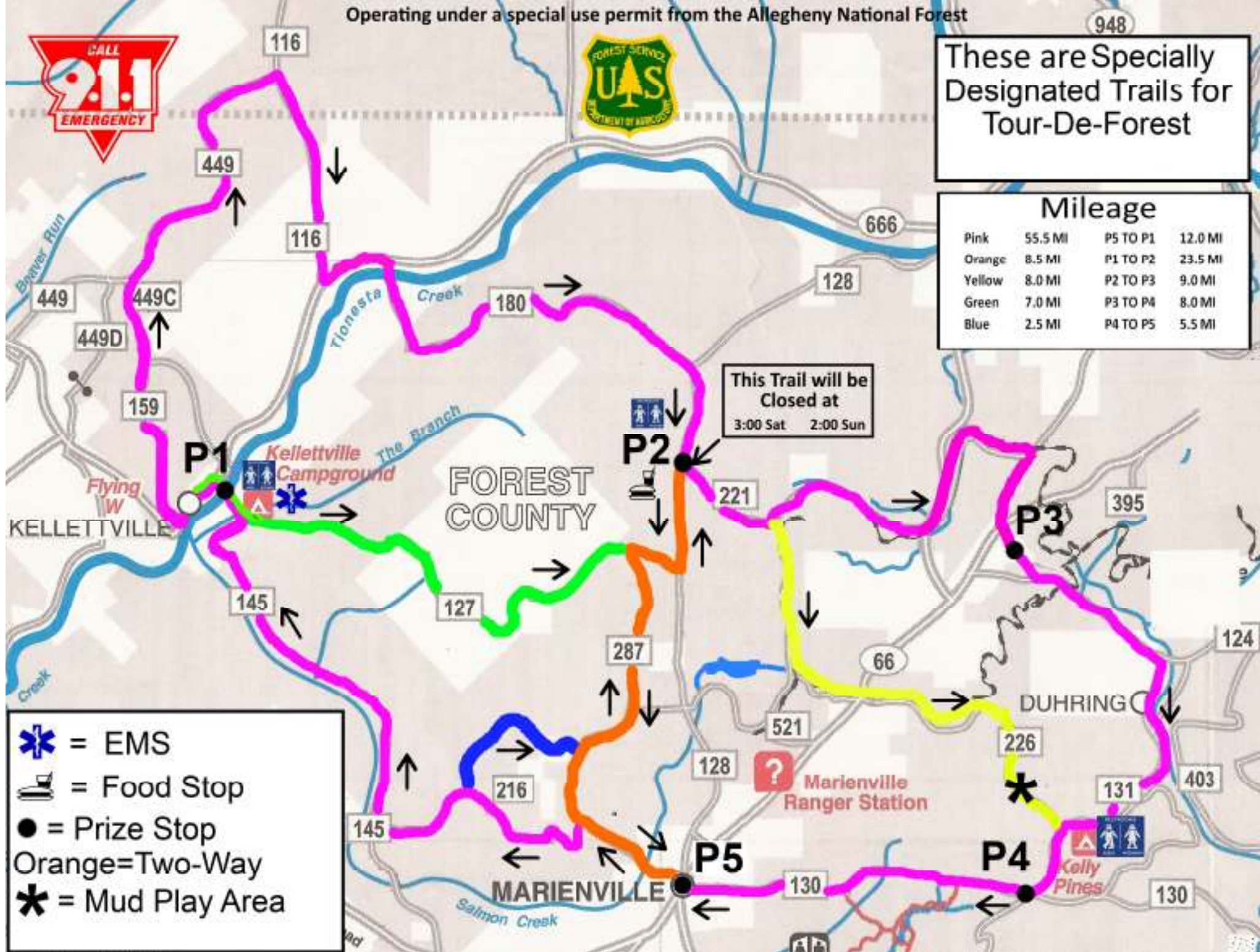
